The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. G.S. 163-111 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:		
"(e1) Option for Voting Centers During Second Primary. – A county board of elections		
may opt to file a plan with the State Board of Elections for approval to provide for a limited		
number of precincts to be opened during a potential second primary. If the plan is approved by		
the State Board prior to the date ballots are printed for the primary, the county board of		
elections may open fewer than all of the precincts for voting during a second primary as stated		
	ed plan. The plan shall comply with all of the following:
