Short Title: Shoot Firearm Near School/Increase Penalty. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO DISCHARGE A FIREARM WITHIN ONE  
3 THOUSAND FEET OF THE BOUNDARY OF REAL PROPERTY USED FOR AN  
4 ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL.  
5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  
6 SECTION 1. Article 35 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by  
7 adding a new section to read:  
8 "§ 14-277.6. Discharging certain barreled weapons or a firearm within certain proximity  
9 of educational property.  
10 Any person who willfully or wantonly discharges or attempts to discharge any firearm or  
11 barreled weapon capable of discharging shot, bullets, pellets, or other missiles at a muzzle  
12 velocity of at least 600 feet per second within 1,000 feet of the boundary of real property used  
13 for an elementary or secondary school is guilty of a Class I felony."  
14 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2013, and applies to  
15 offenses committed on or after that date.
