Short Title: Mission Foundation Special Plate. (Public)

Sponsors: Representatives Moffitt, Ramsey, and Fisher (Primary Sponsors).

2 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO PRODUCE A SPECIAL  
3 REGISTRATION PLATE FOR MISSION HEALTHCARE FOUNDATION, INC.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:

6 "(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration plates:

7 ...

8 () Mission Foundation. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in  
9 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate may bear a phrase and logo  
10 selected by Mission Healthcare Foundation, Inc.

11 ...."

12 SECTION 2. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

13 "(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge a single  
14 Legion of Valor, 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of War registration plate to a  
15 recipient of a Legion of Valor award, a 100% disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war each  
16 year. The preceding special registration plates are subject to the regular motor vehicle  
17 registration fees in G.S. 20-88, if the registered weight of the vehicle is greater than 6,000  
18 pounds. All other special registration plates are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration  
19 fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:

26 SECTION 3. G.S. 20-79.7(b) reads as rewritten:

27 "(b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the Collegiate  
28 and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway Fund. The Division  
29 must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a)  
30 of this section among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the Collegiate and  
31 Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), the Natural Heritage Trust Fund (NHTF), which  
32 is established under G.S. 113-77.7, and the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund, which is  
33 established under G.S. 113-44.15, as follows:

4           **SECTION 4.** G.S. 20-81.12 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5           "(b126) Mission Foundation. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for a  
6 Mission Foundation plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer  
7 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the  
8 sale of Mission Foundation plates to Mission Healthcare Foundation, Inc., to support its  
9 mission of sustaining and expanding its provision of health services to Western North  
10 Carolina."

11           **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2013.
