AN ACT REQUIRING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY AND REPORT ON WHETHER EXISTING MINIMUM DESIGN DAILY FLOW RATES FOR

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The Legislative Research Commission shall study whether and to what extent the rules establishing minimum design daily flow rates for normal use and occupancy situations, as set forth in 15A NCAC 02T .0114, should be updated to reflect actual usage and volume under normal use and occupancy situations. The Commission shall report its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislative changes, to the 2013 General Assembly when it reconvenes in 2014.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
