Short Title: Discharge Firearm With Reckless Disregard. (Public) Representative Farmer-Butterfield. Sponsors: Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO CREATE THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF DISCHARGING A FIREARM WITH RECKLESS DISREGARD. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 36 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 14-280.3. Discharge a firearm with reckless disregard. Unless the conduct is covered under another provision of law that provides greater punishment, any person deliberately bent on mischief who discharges a firearm in such a reckless and wanton manner as to manifest a mind utterly without regard for human life and social duty and as a result causes serious injury to another person is guilty of a Class F felony. If a person commits an offense under this section and causes serious bodily injury, the person is guilty of a Class D felony." SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2013, and applies to
