9	SECTION 1. G.S. 14-269.2(g) is amended by adding the following new	
10	subdivisions to read:

12		accordance with Article 54B of this Chapter or considered valid under
13		G.S. 14-415.24, provided that all of the criteria listed in this subdivision are
14		met:
15		<u>a.</u> The weapon is a handgun.
16		b. The handgun is in a closed compartment or container within the
17		person's locked motor vehicle or in a locked container securely
18		affixed to the person's motor vehicle.
19		<u>c.</u> The person's motor vehicle is located on the educational property.
20	<u>(8)</u>	A handgun kept in a vehicle in accordance with subdivision (7) of this
21		subsection that is removed from the locked motor vehicle or removed from
22		the locked container affixed to the motor vehicle, provided the handgun is
23		used solely for the purpose of defending the lives of the students, faculty
24		employees, or other people against violent attack on the educational
25		property."
26	SEC	CTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2013.
