18 19 **SECTION 1.** This act applies to the City of Greensboro only.

SECTION 2. G.S. 160A-301 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(f) If (i) a motor vehicle is ticketed for a violation of the parking regulations of a municipality, (ii) the ticket or any applicable fines or penalties are not paid within 150 days from the date of the violation, and (iii) ownership of the motor vehicle has not been transferred from the time of the violation until the date on which registration is sought, the municipality may add the amount due to the municipal tax assessed on the motor vehicle for the calendar year following the year in which the violation occurred and report the combined amount to the Division of Motor Vehicles of the Department of Transportation. The Division shall treat the combined amount as unpaid municipal taxes for purposes of G.S. 20-50.4. Amounts resulting from violations and collected pursuant to this subsection retain the same status as if the municipality collected the amounts directly."

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2013, and applies to tickets issued for violations occurring on or after that date.
