11	(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article, when contracting for			
12	construction or repair work or for the purchase of apparatus, supplies, materials, or equipment			
13	involving the expenditure of public money, counties and municipalities may give preference to			
14	the lowest responsible, responsive local bidder if both of the following conditions are met: (i)			
15	the bid of the lowest responsible, responsive local bidder is no greater than five percent (5%) or			
16	ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), whichever is less, of the bid of the lowest responsible,			
17	responsive non-local bidder; and (ii) the lowest responsible, responsive local bidder matches			
18	the bid of the lowest responsible, responsive non-local bidder.
