6	SECTION 2. G.S. 18B-1002(d) reads as rewritten:			
7	"(d) Administrative Procedure A permit issued pursuant to this section shall not be			
8	issued less than 10 days before any qualifying event described in subdivisions (1) through (5)			
9	of subsection (a) of this section. The Commission shall notify the ALE Division not more than			
10	three business days after the date a permit is issued pursuant to this section of the name and			
11	address of the applicant, the address of the event, and any conditions placed on the permit			
12	pursuant to subsection (c) of this section. Denial or revocation of a permit under this section			
13	shall not entitle the applicant or permittee to a hearing under Chapter 150B."			
14	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to permits			
15	issued on or after that date.
