The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 160A-211(b) reads as rewritten:		
"(b) <del>B</del>	Barbershop and Salon Restriction. Restrictions. – A privilege license tax	levied by
a city on a <del>barbershop or a beauty salon</del> <u>business listed in this subsection</u> may not exceed <del>two</del>		
dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) for eachthe following:		
<u>(1</u>	1) For a barbershop or a beauty salon, a rate of two dollars and fi	fty cents
	(\$2.50) per barber, manicurist, cosmetologist, beautician, or other	operator
	employed in the barbershop or beauty salon.employed.	
<u>(2</u>	2) For a business entity that is a wholesaler, receiver, distributor, and	importer
	of fruits and vegetables only, a rate of one hundred dollars (\$100.00	)."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2013.
