1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO MAKE IT A CLASS 1 MISDEMEANOR TO TRESPASS ON SCHOOL 3 GROUNDS. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 SECTION 1. Article 22 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by 6 adding a new section to read: 7 "§ 14-132.3. Trespass on school grounds. For purposes of this section, the term "school premises" includes any school 8 building and any educational property as defined by G.S. 14-269.2 that is within 500 feet of a 9 10 school building. During the period of one hour prior to the start of school and one hour after the conclusion of a school session, it is unlawful for any person to enter the premises of a public or 12 private elementary, middle, or secondary school unless the person meets one of the following 13 qualifications: 14 15 Is an enrolled student in, a parent or guardian of an enrolled student in, or an <u>(1)</u> employee of the school or school district. 16 Has permission or an invitation from a school official to be on the school 17 (2) 18 premises. Is attending a school event, class, or meeting to which the person, the public, 19 (3) 20 or a student's family is invited. Has reported the person's presence on the school premises in the manner (4) 22 required for visitors to school. 23 A violation of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor." (c)

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2013, and applies to
