

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN PROHIBITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS 3 REGARDING PYROTECHNICS DO NOT APPLY TO THEATRICAL 4 PERFORMANCES. FILM PRODUCTIONS. AND OTHER THEATRICAL 5 PRESENTATIONS PRODUCED, PRESENTED, OR SPONSORED BY THE 6 UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA SCHOOL OF THE ARTS THAT ARE 7 PRESENTED ON PROPERTY OWNED OR LEASED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF 8 NORTH CAROLINA SCHOOL OF THE ARTS. 9 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 10 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-410 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 11 "(a4) It is permissible for pyrotechnics to be purchased, possessed, received, used, 12 handled, exhibited, or discharged for theatrical performances, film productions, or other 13 presentations that are theatrical in nature produced, presented, or sponsored by the University 14 of North Carolina School of the Arts on any property owned or rented by the University of 15 North Carolina School of the Arts. The provisions of subsection (a1) of this section do not apply in the circumstances set out in this subsection." 16 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 14-413 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 17 18 This section shall not apply to theatrical performances, film productions, or other "(c) 19 presentations that are theatrical in nature produced, presented, or sponsored by the University 20 of North Carolina School of the Arts on any property owned or rented by the University of 21 North Carolina School of the Arts." 22 SECTION 3. G.S. 58-82A-2 reads as rewritten: 23 "§ 58-82A-2. Individual training requirements. 24 An individual may not use, handle, exhibit, or discharge pyrotechnics in connection (a) 25 with a concert or public exhibition, as allowed under Article 54 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes, unless the individual successfully completes the training approved or offered by the 26 27 Commissioner of Insurance through the Office of State Fire Marshal or meets all of the 28 following conditions: 29 (1)Is an active member in good standing with a local fire or rescue department 30 and has experience in pyrotechnics or explosives, as verified by the State 31 Fire Marshal. 32 (2)Possesses the professional qualifications required by the State Fire Marshal

or the professional qualifications required by the jurisdiction where 33 34 permitting is being sought, whichever is greater. The professional 35 qualifications set by the State Fire Marshal may not be less than the voluntary minimum professional qualifications for all levels of fire service 36

8	SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
