The corporate limits of the Town of Clayton are increased by annexing the following described tract: Tract 2, containing 3.964 acres, more or less, according to a plat prepared by True Line Surveying, P.C., and recorded November 21, 2014, in Plat Book 80, Page 389, Johnson County Register of Deeds.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective June 30, 2015.

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
