8	SECTION 2. G.S. 7B-302 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:		
9	" <u>(c1)</u> If	an assessment indicates that abuse, neglect, or dependency has occu	rred, the
10	director shall	make diligent efforts to contact the noncustodial parent regarding the al	legations
11	of abuse, neglect, or dependency involving the juvenile, when applicable. However, the		
12	director shall not contact the noncustodial parent regarding allegations of abuse, neglect, or		
13	dependency when there is documented evidence that contacting the noncustodial parent would		
14	present a safety threat or risk of harm to the juvenile and is not in the juvenile's best interest."		
15	SI	ECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
